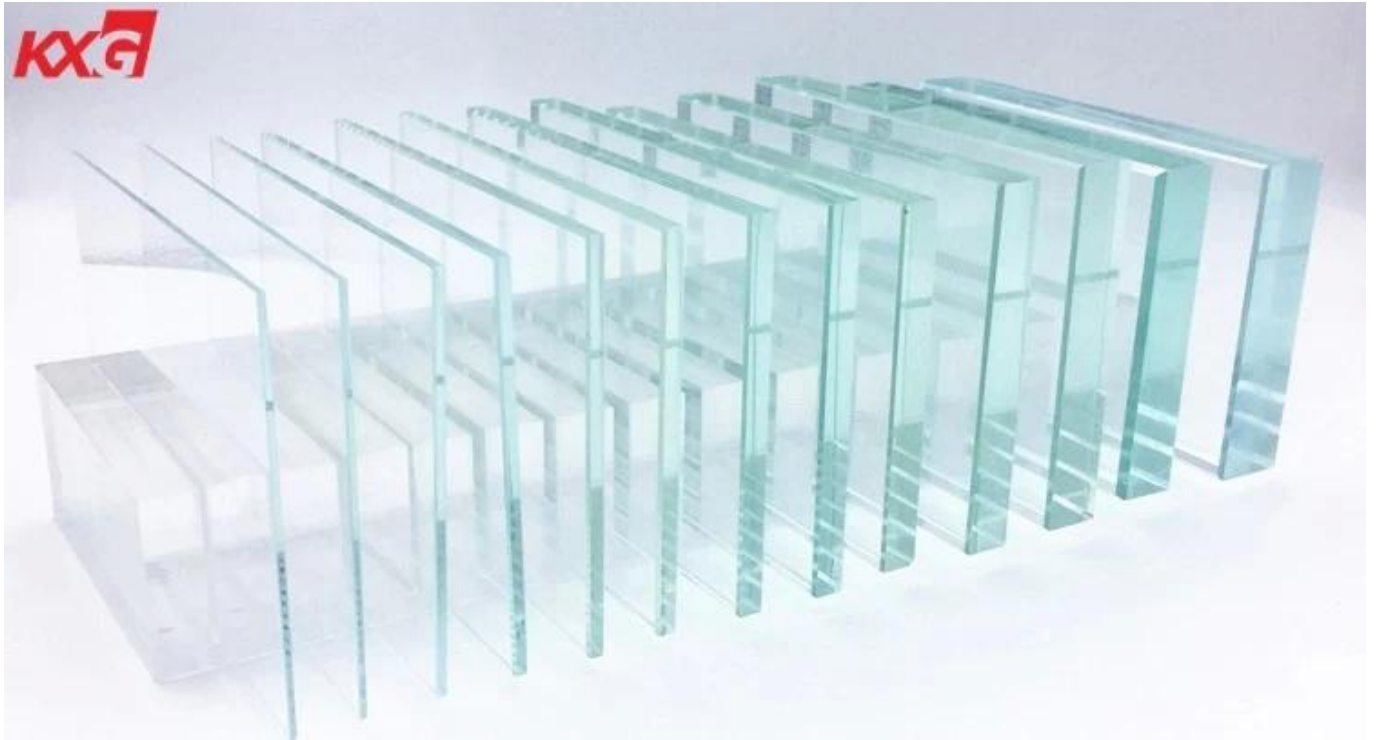


15 mm tempered glass - **15 mm** toughened glass

15 mm tempered glass is a type of safety glass that is heat-treated to increase its strength and resistance to breakage. It is commonly used in applications where safety is a concern, such as in automotive windows, aircraft windows, and in buildings for doors and windows. The glass is made by heating a regular glass pane to a high temperature and then rapidly cooling it, which causes the surface to compress and the interior to expand, creating a state of internal stress that makes the glass much stronger than ordinary glass.
